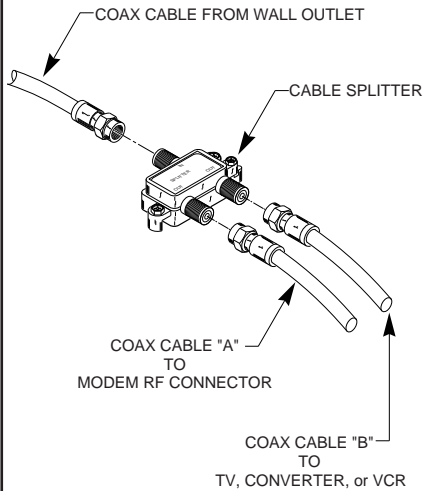
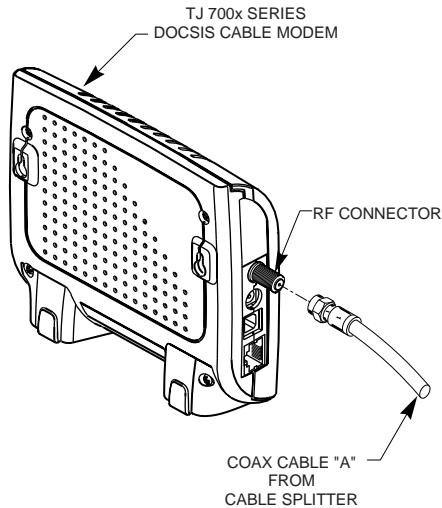


Quick Install Guide for a Typical USB Interface

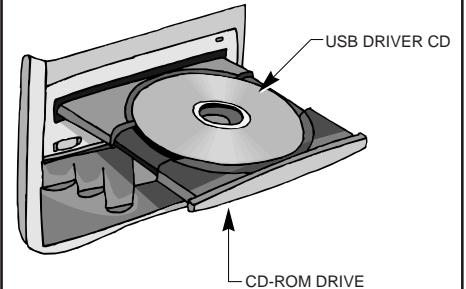
1 Install Splitter



2 Connect Coax Cable to Modem

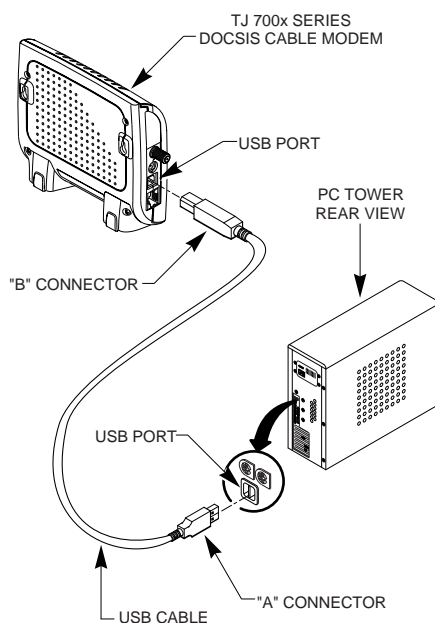


3 INSTALL USB DRIVERS

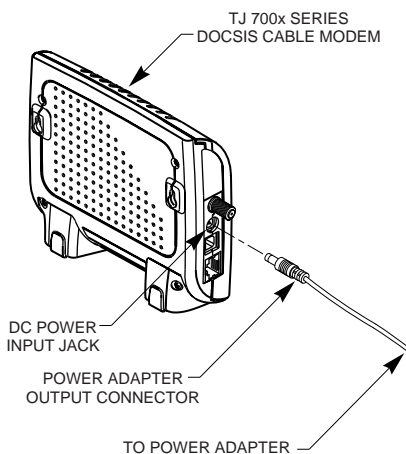


Before you install the USB Cable, you must install a USB Driver. Insert the USB Driver CD that came with the modem into the computer CD-ROM drive and follow the online instructions. You may have to tell the computer what drive your CD-ROM drive is.

4 Connect USB Cable to Modem and Computer



5 Connect Power Adapter to Modem



Do not plug the AC Adapter into an AC outlet at this time.

6 Starting the Modem

To start the modem, plug the AC Adapter into an appropriate AC outlet immediately after closing Acrobat Reader.

Your modem will automatically boot up and start scanning for an active cable modem channel.
